Our sliding scale fee schedule is based on the attached, "Guidelines to Determine Eligible Students". Please check one:

\$10 per month, starting August, for 10 months or \$95 per year one time payment by August 31st

\$16 per month, starting August, for 10 months or \$155 per year one time payment by August 31st

SCHOOL VIOLIN INFORMATION 2015-2016

Attention: 4th, 5th & 6th Grade Parents/Guardians:

All students in the 4th through 6th grades will be participating in Violin Class this school year. If you do not already own a violin, this letter is intended to help your student be prepared for this class. Students will not be required to purchase a violin book this year.

Option One: School Violin Rental

Mountain Oak has a limited number of violins for rent at a sliding scale rate. These are awarded on a 1st- come, 1st - served and need basis. To apply, fill out the attached *School Violin Application* and *Guidelines To Determine Eligible Students* and return to the school office promptly. You will be notified on or before the first day of school if your child has been awarded a school violin rental.

Option Two: Outside Violin Rental

The Fiddle Doctor, has rental violins for Mountain Oak students. This option is exciting because the rental is through a local business and a portion of the rent can go towards the purchase of the violin.

Option Three: Purchase

There are many places you can go to purchase your own violin. Below are a few suggestions as well as a sizing guide. (Beware of cheap ebay instruments, as some people have purchased unplayable violins without knowing!)

The Fiddle Doctor: Sells new and used stringed instruments. They are highly trustworthy and Mountain Oak's only choice for repairs and supplies. See their contact info above.

Kennedy Violins: kennedyviolins.com has good quality instruments at comparably affordable prices. Call them at 800-779-0242. If you mention that your purchase is for a class at Mountain Oak School they may give you a free upgrade.

Violin Sizing Guidelines		
* Measure from the middle of the left palm to the neck, with left arm and hand fully extended out perpendicular to the body (as if holding a violin).		
Arm Length (inches)	Approx. Age	Violin Size
20" to 22"	6-10 yrs	1/2
22" to 23.5"	9-11 yrs	3/4
23.5" & up	9-Adult	Full
