	The mask policy was informed by and written to keep MOS within	
	state mandates;	
	Amidst changing state guidelines we need to communicate	
	clearly and adhere to policies on campus;	
	The existing policy was read and reviewed;	
	2 scholarly articles were provided board members that cover	
	current mask exemption gray areas;	
	In addition to current MOS policy the following 2 clauses were	
	added:	
	1.Exemptions will be authenticated and evaluated on an	
	individual basis.	
	2. Employees with validated exemptions may have	
	accommodations that could include reassignment of position or	
	duties.	
	It came to light during the board meeting that daily mask wearing	
	infractions are happening. Compliance issues will be addressed:	
	Infraction 1. Verbal request for masks & social distancing	
	Infraction 2. Written request for masks & social distancing	
	Infraction 3. Consequences to be determined	
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	It was noted again that adults on campus must be responsible for their own compliance, MOS does not have any one person who is	
	their own compliance. MOS does not have any one person who is	
	available for "monitoring" adult actions. The board implores all	
	adults on campus to monitor their own behavior and to comply	
	with state mandates regardless of personal beliefs.
