Monthly Board Meeting

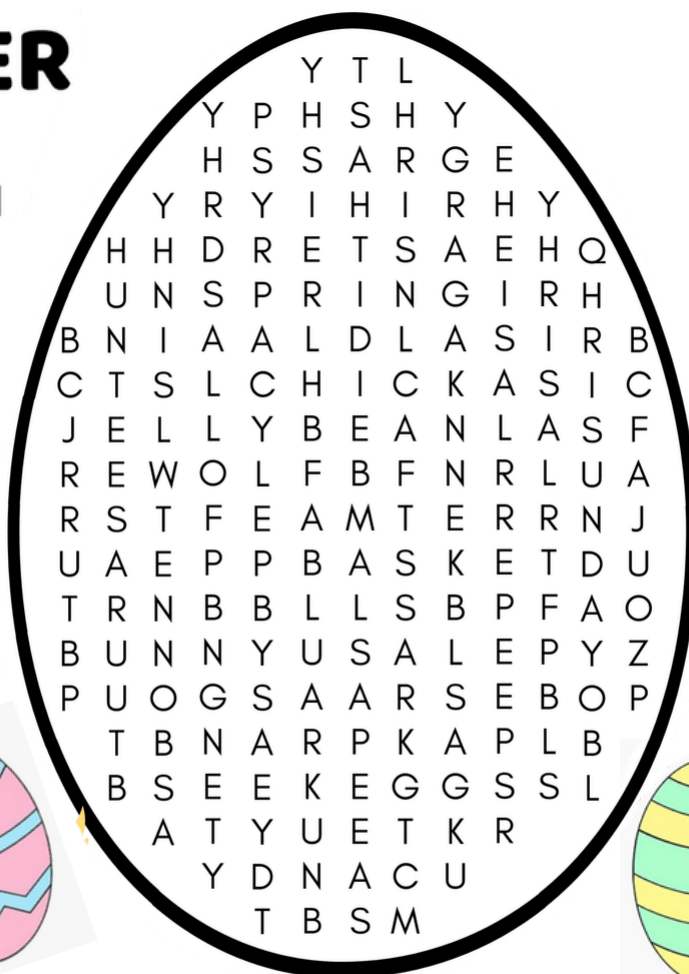

MOS SCIENCE FAIR!

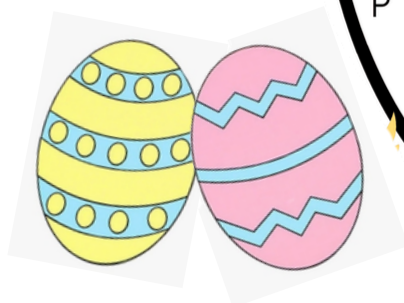
APRIL 22ND IN THE GREAT HALL UNTIL 5:30

Lavender Rose Preschool

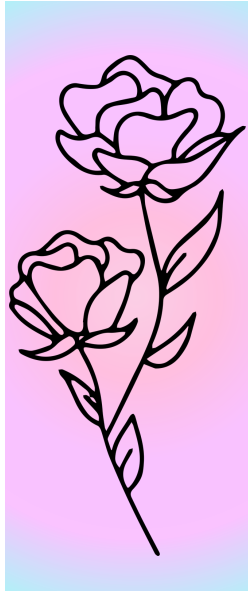
April is a month full of renewal, growth, and gentle celebrations. As the earth awakens around us, our classroom will reflect the beauty and rhythm of the season.

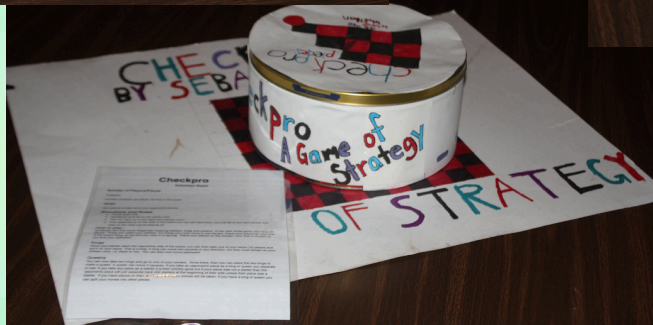
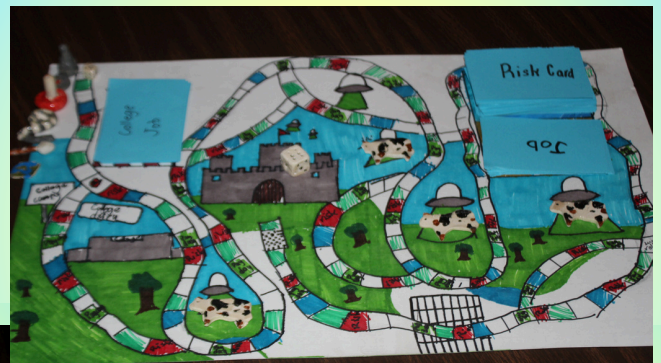
In the spirit of wonder and joy, we will celebrate Easter with simple stories, songs, and a preschool Easter egg hunt!

Come and Learn at the Living Museum of American History

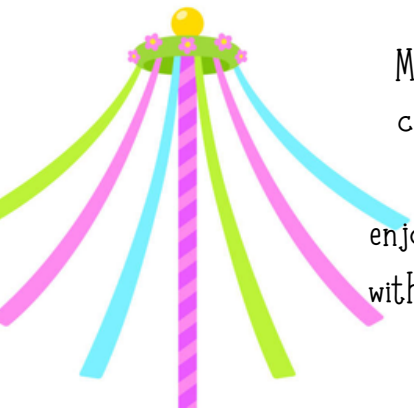
